Our February Program will be presented by Dann Dunst. Dann will discuss *Oncidium Tolumnia* - a very pretty *Oncidium* genera with a plethora of colors! He will discuss their cultural aspects, in particular how well they are suited for the beginner as well as the experienced growers and how well they are suited for the growing conditions of the Inland Empire.

Dann has two greenhouses, one intermediate growing and one cool growing, and has been growing orchids for many years. His interest in orchids started with *Cymbidiums*, and then he gradually added a collection of *Vanda*, *Miltonia*, *Paphs* and *Phrags*. and his principle interests the *Plueorthallids* in which he currently has over 150 plants of that genera - mostly *Masdevallia* and *Dracula*.

Dann is a past President of the RSBCOS, current Treasurer of the SOSC Committee, member of the Board of Directors for the SGVOH, past District Director of the Palms to Pines District of the CGCI. He attended the World Orchid Conference in Miami Florida in 2008 and the WOC in Singapore in 2011.

Dann is a retired middle school teacher, and aside from raising orchids, maintains several aviaries where he keeps exotic species of pheasants, doves, finches, starlings and other soft bills. Dann will be bringing the POT table with a variety of *Tolumnia*.

Board Meeting




