Program for September

The speaker for September meeting will be Bill Loy. He will present a program on an Orchid Conservation Alliance (OCA) trip to Chiapas Mexico.

Bill's Bio:

Bill has lived in California since 1954.

Veteran U.S. Army 1971 – 1974

Graduated from UCSD with a double major; BA Biology (Biochemistry) and BA American Literature

Worked 25 years in industrial membrane filtration processes (reverse osmosis and ultrafiltration) primarily in sanitary food processing applications.

Worked 11 years full time at Andy's Orchids in everything from basic maintenance to propagation.

Retired in 2015

He grows about 1000 orchids, almost all species, 75% mounted, in his yard and in my 20' X 35' heated greenhouse – he was a late bloomer in orchids, just a houseplant type grower until the late 90's.

He has been on three Orchid Conservation Alliance trips, two to central Brazil and one to Chiapas Mexico.

This is a program that you will not want to miss, and the snacks are good as well.

AOS Orchid Show—Saturday and Sunday, October 5 & 6, 2019

The **Morongo Basin Orchid Festival AOS show** is sponsored by Gubler's Orchids and the Riverside/San Bernardino Counties Orchid Society. This is our show. We need everyone able to help, participate and show your orchids. The plants are as important as the workers.

Choose at least 2 things from the following list that you will take responsibility for during and before the show. Bringing your orchids is important and may be one of the responsibilities.

1. Bring Your Orchids from Friday 2 – 4 pm and Saturday 8 am. – 9:30 am. They may be taken home Sunday at 3 PM. **Please contact Ron Lang, if you have blooming orchids to show but are unable to get to Gubler's. email: rflangx25@gmail.com or 951-553-5237**
2. Set up Fri Oct 4 starting at 12 noon.
3. Hauling the equipment to the show. We will need it by 12 noon on Friday Oct. 4.
4. You may choose a day, either Friday or Saturday, to take in entries from 2 – 4 pm on Friday and from 8 am – 9:30 am on Saturday.
5. Need on Friday and Saturday is the same time to wrap the pots that are entered.
6. On Friday and Saturday to take in and assist exhibitors to enter their orchids.
7. Make and display floral designs featuring orchids. Orchids will be available at the show. Must be completed and place by 9:30 am on Saturday Oct 8. The designs may be taken home Sunday 3 pm.
8. Take down the show from 3 pm until finished. We also need vehicles available to help take society supplies back.
9. Hosts and Hostesses will be needed both Saturday and Sunday while the show is on. You will welcome and greet visitors to the show. You will answer questions and let them know who we are as a Society. Information will be available for visitors to take home and consider joining our Society.
10. On Saturday help AOS judges as needed.
